

EFMP Requests for Exception to Housing Policy

Priority housing is only given to Service Members in the Wounded Warrior Program, Warriors in Transition and Key and Essential personnel (as designated by Command).

All housing assignments are done through the Welcome Center and are based on rank and numbers of bedrooms required.

ADA requests (for single level only) are also processed according to rank and number of bedrooms required.

If a family needs a reasonable accommodation under ADA, they must present a formal letter signed by a physician (dated within six months of presenting) to the Welcome Center when the Soldier/Family requests housing.

Fort Belvoir houses are assigned on a first-come, first-served basis and are based on what is available at the time.

If Soldier/Family is already living in post housing and they need a reasonable accommodation under ADA, they should contact their Community Manager who will advise them of what they will need to do.
