The **Parent Advisory Committee (PAC)** is a volunteer parent group established to further the connection between home, your child, the North Post Child Development Center (NP CDC) and your child's classroom and teachers.

Our PAC is very active, serving as a critical liaison between our parents and the NP CDC Staff. We are a forum for sharing issues of parental importance and concern and, as a group, can provide a unified voice to the NP CDC Director on such issues. We also serve as a communication conduit for parents who may otherwise be unable or unwilling to voice concerns directly to the NP CDC staff. But mostly, we are parents who are excited and appreciative of the wonderful teachers and staff in our center and the care and learning opportunities they provide our children — we want to be involved in making the NP CDC even better!



The PAC meets monthly on the first Thursday of the month from 1700-1800. During the meetings, we solicit parental concerns and ideas, discuss program changes, and provide updates to parents on upcoming events. In addition to discussion of NP CDC issues, the meetings often feature information or presentations on parenting, safety, and general interest issues.
