

Pool Admission

- Admission to the pool is FREE for Fort Belvoir Officers' Club Members, their spouse and their child dependents.
- No children under the age of 13 will be allowed to enter without parental supervision.
- Admission to the pool will be by presenting a season pass or daily admission ticket at the Pool Entrance.
- Daily passes are sold at the Pool Entrance for non-members.



Daily Admission Charges:

- Adults: \$8.00
- Children 4-18 years old: \$5.00
- Children 3 and under: FREE

Season Passes for Non-Members

Seasonal family passes can be purchased at the Membership Office for a \$175.00 fee. This fee includes a 3 month membership and pool usage for immediate club member, spouse, and children up to 21 years of age.

Pool Passes

Pool passes are NOT transferable! Any person found entering the pool facility with a pass issued to another person will be denied use of the pool for the entire season and have their pass confiscated.

Members' pool passes may be picked-up, beginning May 3, 2010, at the Cashier's Office. Members must be up-to-date with their membership to receive the pass. New members signing up during the pool season must pay for a full year of membership up-front, for the use of the pool and club.

Special Events

Times and dates for Kid's Night are posted at the Officers' Club prior to the event. The pool closes one hour early the evening of Kid's Night.

Pool will open as scheduled except during inclement weather or when necessary to close for emergency maintenance and repair.

Swimming Lessons

Swimming lessons are available and can be purchased at the Pool House. For one session, which includes 8 classes over a two week period, there is a \$70.00 charge per participant.
