

# MWR Cards

They are issued at the Community Center to eligible patrons who do not have a CAC (DoD's Common Access Card). Contractors who work on post and then family members of DOD Civilians tend to fall into this category. All other patrons can use their CAC or family member ids at DFMWR facilities. As contractors are often times not provided a CAC and Family Members of DOD Civilians do not have the ability to get a CAC either, DFMWR has made these MWR cards available.

## How to Obtain an MWR Card

A DOD Civilian Family Member must go to the Community Center with their sponsor to get a MWR Card. Once they have the MWR card they can use any DFMWR facility on their own without their sponsor. A contractor must have the government POC who oversees the contract write a letter to the Community Center with the contractors names on it and then they can take that to the Community Center to get a MWR Card.
