**Amendment to 2008-2009 Fort Belvoir Hunting Fact Sheet**

1. Areas H-1, H-2, H-4, H-5 and H-6 will reopen to hunting beginning Monday October 20 through the remainder of the 2008-2009 Season. Hunting in these areas is restricted to Monday – Friday from 30 minutes before sunrise to 1500 hours (3pm). These areas are closed to hunting whenever Fairfax County public schools are closed. Only elevated stand hunting is permitted.

Area H-1 is located north and east of the NCO Club parking lot bordered on the south by Surveyor Road and on the north by Belvoir property line. The western boundary is the abandoned roadway from the NCO parking lot to Washington Road and the wood line to Stevens Road. The maximum number of hunters is three.

Area H-2 is bordered by the Dogue Creek tidal flats to the east and the dirt road to the southwest border this area. Deer removal is permitted from the parking area only. A key will be permanently affixed to the parking permit for this area. The hunter is to open the gate and immediately close and lock the gate upon entering the assigned hunting area. The gate must be closed and locked at all other times. The western half of H-2, marked by pink flagging along the drainage ditch behind Markham School, will be closed from November 15, 2008 through the remainder of the hunting season. The maximum number of hunters is two with the intention of use by a pair of hunters electing to hunt together. Otherwise this area will be assigned to one hunter only.

Area H-4 is located between the sewage lift station below Jadwin Loop and the Officer's Club. A key will be permanently affixed to the parking permit for this area. The hunter is to open the gate and immediately close and lock the gate upon entering the assigned hunting area. The gate must be closed and locked at all times. Area H-4 will be closed from November 15, 2008 through the remainder of the hunting season. Maximum number of hunters is two.

Area H-5 is bordered by the Potomac River to the East and Belvoir Village Housing to the West. Patrick Road is the northern boundary and Fairfax Ruins and gravesite are on the south end. The maximum number of hunters is two with the intention of use by a pair of hunters electing to hunt together. Otherwise this area will be assigned to one hunter.

Area H-6 is bordered on the south by the CRML Compound fence and on the north by Fairfax Village Housing Area and the dirt road leading into the pump station at Fairfax Ruins. The Potomac River is the east boundary and the west boundary is the old perimeter fence road at the R&D Center. The maximum number of hunters is two.
